



February's Car of the Month 1928 Buick Master Six Coupe

The Buick Master Six was built from 1925 to 1928. Buick coined the name "Master Six" for the high-end cars powered by a 77-horsepower engine released the year before. The Master Six was available on a 120-inch or 128-inch platform. Both Buick's Standard Six and Master Six were dramatically restyled for 1928. Drue and his father restored this Buick and had fun doing it.

This Month's M.A.M. Team Member is Richard Weiland

Richard is a retired Electrical Contractor, and Business Manager for the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW). Richard grew up in Dubuque, Iowa, the youngest of 3 boys. His father, a UAW member, and brothers taught him to admire and appreciate the automobile and its history. They all owned and took pride in each of their cars. He attended 2 years of college and a 4-year apprenticeship program of the (IBEW) to become a Journeyman Electrician. After completing school, he moved with his wife and 2 kids to Arizona. He was elected as an officer of the IBEW local, and then as a Business Manager overseeing the employment of almost 2,000 electricians in Arizona. Richard served as a trustee on Taft-Hartley trusts of pension, benefits, and healthcare for electricians, and was a founder of Union Savings and Loan, that financed union-built projects. At age 40, he and his wife started an electrical construction company that they operated successfully for a quarter century. His love for cars continued and expanded to boats, ATVS, sand rails, and dirt bikes. In younger years, he and friends built 1923 T-Bucket with Chrysler 413 ci. torque flite. Also, raced a fuel dragster, 426 ci. Chrysler/Fiat Body. At the same time, raced an 18-ft Sanger boat 329 ci. Chrysler Hemi (80 MPH).



Richard has owned more than 50 cars: 1936 Ford Coupe 1923 Ford T-Bucket 1968 Ford 350 Mustang 2006 Corvette supercharged 2012 Cadillac CTS-V Wagon (640 HP) 2023 Cadillac Lyriq Just to mention a few!
